

What we will supply

The SpinIN Committee has arranged sponsorship for the printing and binding of Julian's book, which will be presented to you free of charge. Furthermore, one piece of fabric for each participant has also been sponsored.

TasTAFE has kindly provided the wonderful facilities, supervising staff, tea & coffee and pattern making paper. Industrial sewing machines will be available to use. Please ask for assistance if you are not familiar with operating this type of equipment.

What you need to bring

You will need to bring three pieces of medium weight fabric, each 3x1m in size. We suggest old duvet covers or bed sheets, as they will be used for prototyping only.

- Sewing kit with fabric scissors, measuring tape, thread clippers and pins & needles
- a selection of paint brushes and water based paints (acrylic, gouache, inks)
- Art materials of your choice (crayons, pastel chalks, etc)
- Paper scissors, pencils, rulers and squares, if you have them
- A note book
- A camera
- Your confirmation email from when you made the booking, or some form of ID.
